The students of the school, which started its education life in 1892, left the following note to their teachers when they went to the Çanakkale war in 1915 as a volunteer, and all of them were martyred. (Teacher, give your blessing, we are going to Çanakkale to become a Martyr) You can visit the classroom held in memory of our martyred students in our Atatürk and Congress Museum.

In memory of Şekercizade İsmail Bey, who hosted 28 of the delegates participating in the Sivas Congress in his own houses and mansions for 32 days, you can visit the exhibition of the Sivas mansion main room of the period in our museum.

Sivas Congress Cafeteria

The meals served to the delegates attending the Sivas Congress were welcomed by the notables of Sivas, and mainly dried beans, rice and grape compote, which is known as the most favorite meal of Atatürk, was served. You can visit the dinnerware used at that time and the spoon and fork used by Atatürk in our museum.

Telephone and Telegraph

You can visit the telegraph machine Atatürk used to send telegrams with the most important subjects and the telephone where Atatürk's original voice was heard in our museum, when Sivas and our museum were used as headquarters during the 108-day national struggle period.

Inscription and Sivas Carpet

It was built as the School of Sultan in 1892 by the Governor of Sivas, Mehmet Memduh Pasha, with the instructions of Abdulhamid II, the sultan of the period. You can visit the inscription of the building and the carpet depicting the portrait of Sivas Governor Mehmet Memduh Pasha, who had the commissioned the building, in our museum.



Atatürk - Hikmet BORAN and Mazhar Mufit KANSU Silicone Sculptures

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Hikmet BORAN, who attended the Sivas Congress as the Istanbul delegate at the age of 17 to represent the medical students, had conversations with Atatürk when the heated sessions of the Sivas Congress were interrupted for 10 minutes. As a result of these speeches, a strong step was taken towards the National Struggle with the slogan "Either Independence or Death", which was first mentioned at the Sivas Congress. You can visit the silicone sculptures made in reference to this memory of Hikmet Boran and Atatürk in our museum.

Atatürk's Arrival in Sivas

You can visit the silicone sculptures designed to revive the arrival of Atatürk in Sivas on September 2, 1919.

Sivas Congress Hall

You can visit the historical congress hall in our museum, where the decisions of the Sivas Congress, which left its mark on the National Struggle, were taken between 4-11 September 1919.
